McLean-Pedersen Endowment Scholarship

The Paris and Henry County Healthcare Foundation is offering one scholarship of \$6,000, payable over four years (\$1,500 per year) to a graduate from McKenzie High School. The scholarship will be awarded to a student pursuing a career as a nurse, radiology tech, paramedic, physical therapy tech, or a respiratory tech. Students must maintain a 2.75 grade point average to keep the scholarship.

**INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED!**

The student should submit an application along with the required documents to Kelly Winston, using contact information below, **before 4:30 p.m., on Friday, April 26, 2024.**

Please read prior to application:

- Applicants must be a natural born US Citizen residing in Tennessee and must have graduated from a High School in Carroll, Weakley or Henry counties within the preceding 4 years.
- If recipient changes his/her major to one that does not meet the requirements of this scholarship, the scholarship will be withdrawn.
- This scholarship is intended primarily for graduating seniors of McKenzie High school, recent graduates of McKenzie High School who have not yet enrolled in college or graduates of McKenzie High School who are currently enrolled in a degree program at an accredited college or university in the state of Tennessee.
- If no qualified student from McKenzie High School applies, the scholarship may then be awarded to a qualified candidate from another high school in Carroll County, then in Weakley County, and lastly in Henry County. If there are no qualified candidates, the available funds will be returned to the scholarship fund for use the following year.
- Awarded annually, the scholarship will be paid directly to the college or university in the recipient's name on a semester basis for up to 4 years.
- While this scholarship is to be based first upon need, the recipient is expected to maintain a 2.75 GPA in all courses taken. If the recipient fails to maintain this average, the scholarship will be withdrawn. To continue receiving the scholarship in subsequent years, a recipient must provide a transcript at the end of each academic year to the Henry County Healthcare Foundation Board of Directors. It is the responsibility of the student to ensure that grades for the academic year are received by the Board of Directors within ten (10) days after final exams.
- An application, essay, and transcripts are required to be considered. A personal interview may be required. If so, you will be notified by Kelly Winston.
